Everything went well with Ken's upper and lower GI series on May 5. His stomach problems are somewhat better now. However, he still needs your prayers. As some of you already know, **Ken broke his left leg and dislocated his big toe at work on May 10. He also had a puncture wound on his shin**, which was from the accident, not from the broken bone. The next day when he went to the Orthopedic doctor, his toe was put back in place, which relieved a lot of his pain. The doctor doesn't want him to put any weight on his leg, so we are thankful for the use of a motorized wheelchair that a missionary couple left at SLM. The puncture wound is healing, and the swelling has finally gone down a lot, so he is scheduled to get a cast on June 2, which he will wear for three weeks, then have a boot for a week. We are glad that he is no longer taking strong pain medication and is just taking Tylenol as needed. We would appreciate your prayers for complete healing.

Ken had planned to rebuild our front porch this summer, which is in bad condition. We were already planning to add a handicap ramp to the porch. Some men from a local church offered to do the work free of charge, so we will have a new porch and ramp in June. This will be a big help to us! We are thankful that we were able to get the building materials needed at a lower price, and received additional discounts that saved us over \$800. Also, the Maintenance men are taking care of mowing and weed eating our yard while Ken is laid up. **God is so good to provide for our needs in so many different ways!**
