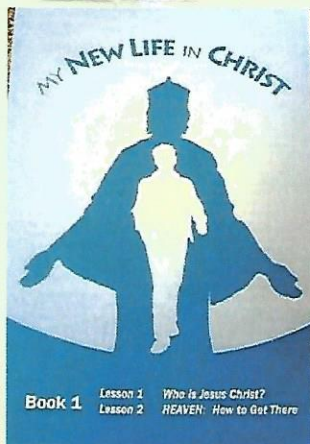

This Christmas card was created in jail by one of our incarcerated students. "**Feliz Navidad**" is Merry Christmas in Spanish.

We use Source of Light Bible studies to reach those of our community that cannot attend Sunday school or church. They are a powerful tool to proclaim the Word of God and make disciples. We send out over 200 Bible study lessons per month and have seen many decisions for Christ, reconciliations and new students each month. We respond to questions, receive requests from new students and pray for their prayer petitions.



This is an example of one of many lesson booklets we use. They vary from Basic Bible studies to more advanced doctrinal lessons.

This past year we sent out 2,402 lessons to students in prisons nationwide, mostly Spanish speakers.
