

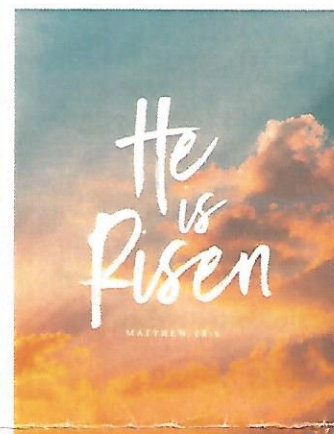

It is with great joy and praise that we receive our students' completed Bible Study lessons from diverse prisons each week. We grade them, answer questions and comments, and then mail them out to each student along with the next lesson..

This week, we noticed that, even among our imprisoned students, discipleship is being practiced. **"Each one teach one"**. From W.C. I. : **FRIGO** has studied for some time, and **LOUIS** has recently begun; **BERTO** at H.T.C. has studied for 11 years and has asked by **RICK** for a Bible in order to take studies also; **ABE** , from S.R.C.I. ,has asked for studies for cellmate **DAVE**; now both are studying and sharing with others.

One student , **EDDY**, is interned in the R.M.C. Hospital, doing his Bible studies while awaiting surgery. **H. LEE informs us of** his new address: The Florida prison system is switching from paper correspondence to a digital tablet form in order to cut down on supposed drug infiltration on the printed page. (Already, colored printing, staples, stickers and birthday or holiday cards are prohibited!). This means every inmate will be corresponding via the same address. This will be a great and exciting challenge for us in Bible Lessons by Mail!
