We had a good visit with family May 24-June 4. Ethan's graduation went well and we had a nice time at his graduation celebration with our family and Ethan's friends. We didn't get to see Char Mattocks on our way to visit Ken's parents, but we did get to visit Carla's nephew, Jason in Ohio, and Carla's sister, Rhonda and brother-in-law, Eddie, in West Virginia. We did an update at a supporting church, where Rhonda and Eddie are members.

The state of Florida has started using a processing center for inmate mail to be viewed on a tablet. Students must write their answers on paper to send to us for grading. Some Florida state prisons have decided to allow Bible lessons to be sent directly to the prison. However, we must call each prison to find out if we can send directly to the prison facility, find out if we need to get prior approval, or if we need to send the Bible lessons to the processing center. We are thankful for computer software that helps us to stay organized. Restrictions can be added to prisons in our database, which generate attention notes that pop up each time a prison with a restriction is accessed. We then attach a printed note to the student's lessons, which indicates what the restrictions are. For example, we have notes that say "Processing Center," "Send directly to the Prison," "No Staples," "Handwrite," and etc. to help us abide by the prison restrictions.

Recently a volunteer named Judy shared that years ago, before she and her husband were married, he was a prison warden. An inmate did SLM Bible lessons, got saved, then got her husband to do the Bible lessons and he got saved. Judy's husband then got his mother to do the Bible lessons and she got saved. He and his mother got numerous friends to do the Bible lessons and some of them got saved. It is exciting and amazing to hear how God uses SLM Bible lessons to reach souls for Christ!

We would appreciate your prayers as we begin to get meetings scheduled in Georgia and West Virginia at supporting churches, as well as visiting individual supporters. We have an update scheduled at a local supporting church on July 31, and plan to visit a couple of individual supporters here in Georgia during July. We appreciate your continued prayer and financial support, even though we have not been able to visit you for some time. God bless you all.
